#### COMPUTER CORNER

This month I am going to write about the console unit of the computer (keyboard). I will also throw in some term names and what they stand for. In going out to purchase a computer try to get one with at least 16K of Byte. In the RAM this is plenty to start with. Ok, now he said he wasn't going to talk computerese but there he goes!!! so lets see what the words mean.

BYTE- a string of binary digits (bits) treated as a unit, often representing one character. The computers memory capacity is often expressed by the number of bytes available. For example, a computer ithe 16K bytes of memory has about 16,000 bytes available for storing programs and data.

RAM— randon access memory; the main memory where program statements and data can be temporarily stored during program execution. New programs and data can be read in, accessed, and changed in RAM. Data stored in RAM is erased whenever the power is turned off of BASIC.

I hope this will help some in the understanding of the meanings, because there are several companies that are giving out deals such as printer, disk drives, etc. for a cheap price but very little ram. Then you have to go out and buy different programs, such as memory expansion, etc.

### MARCO

Many listeners to the HARC repeater have heard oblique refrences to the MARCO nets and were curious about this organization. This article will outline the purpose, structure, and operations of the Medical Amateur Radio Council (MARCO).

The purpose of MARCO is clearly defined in the organization's operating manual: "The purpose of MARCO is to promote good will and fellowship among amateur radio operators, worldwide, who are professionals in the healing arts, or who have an interest in the various medical, dental, and allied fields which constitute the healing arts. On-the-air network operation is considered an integral part of MARCO activity, and is conducted for the purpose of discussing and exchanging medical and technical information, and, wherever possible, to be of public service by assisting medical emergencies and other priority traffic."

MARCO was founded in 1965 in New York City by a group of physicians and dentists interested in forming a medically oriented amateur radio operator's organization. The original membership of 95 has grown to over 570 physicians, dentists, veterinarians, and related medical personnel. There are more than 35 types of medical specialists included in the MARCO membership.

Besides the daily and weekly nets, the organization publishes a monthly newsletter. The newsletter includes articles on antenna theory, reports on Third World Missionary/Medical efforts, the effects of RF on paremakers, and other timely topics.

The net schedule is shown below. Most popular are the 40 meter daily nets and the Sunday Medical Grand Rounds of the Air. All interested amateurs are invited to participate in the nets merely by checking in.

### REPEATER UPDATE

Just before Christmas the repeater started playing its games and 'dropping' out when it felt like it and not responding to an incoming signal when it was inactive.

After a few unsuccessful attempts to repair the transmitter at the site the machine was taken off the air and the transmitter "yanked" for bench repair. The culprit was a dirty trimmer capacitor which was disabling the final stage from turning on. I cleaned the cap and retuned the transmitter and all was okav.

New trimmer capacitors are on order and will have to be replaced. In the return trip to the main site the transmitter was reinstalled, power output checks and SWR measurements were taken and the autopatch codes were changed. The entire autopatch was checked and all frequencies were tweeked. I will be making adjustmentshis favorite technical subjects for 5 on the remote inputs in the near future to correct a frequency drift problem on one of them. Plans are being made to purchase a new repeater lagain on the machine! and all questions and answers concernof Directors meeting. The date and place of this meeting will be announced well in advance on HARCLINE. All interested club members are welcome to attend.
