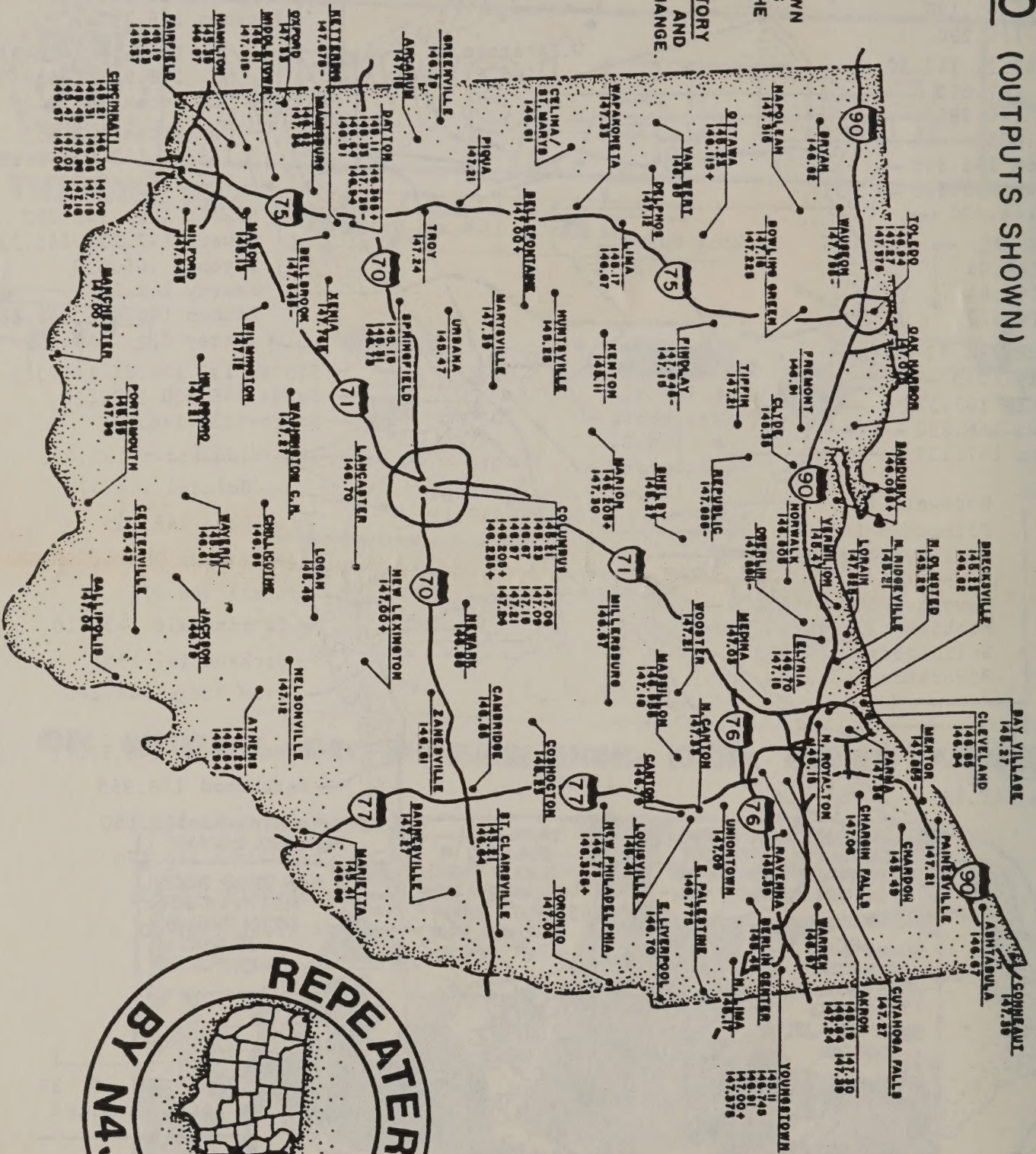


2 METER AMATEUR REPEATERS IN THE NEW JERSEY AREA

### IN SEARCH OF A METAL BUMPER

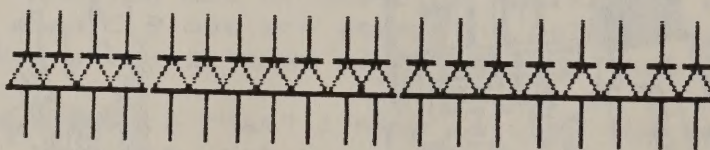

If you do find a car with a metal bumper, you may not like it or maybe you want a 4 door car instead of a 2 door model, since these bumpers can be found only on the 2 door cars.

This was my problem, which I recently went shopping for a new car. My first priority was a chrome bumper so I could easily attach the mount for the antenna. Four doors was my second priority. I had a bumper mount from my old Buick, but it would not fit the new models. When visiting the showrooms, I would lie on the floor trying to determine what was actually under all the plastic and to my surprize there was a galvanized steel bumper underneath.

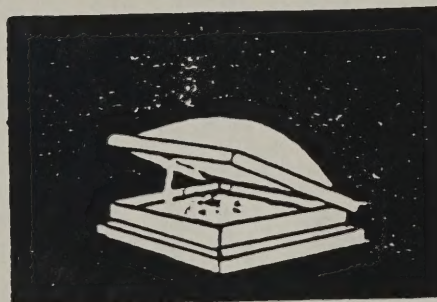

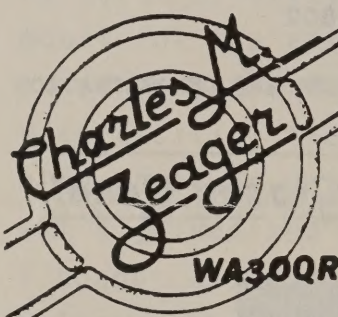

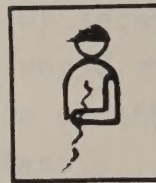
