July

For the eleventh year in a row we participated in the 13 Colonies Special Event as a Bonus Station, and again we outdid ourselves completing 10,356 QSO's for a club record. The event itself garnered 253,283 QSO's over the seven day period. That is a lot of activity.

This year, besides GB13COL in England a third bonus station was added, TM13COL in France

Joined by members of the The Phil-Mont Mobile Radio Club, Philadelphia Digital Radio Association, and Villanova University Amateur Radio Club, HARC worked all 50 states, 78 countries and 6 Continents on 10M, 12M, 15M, 17M, 20M, 30M, 40M, 80M, 160M, 6M, 2M, 70cm (440) using SSB, CW, PSK31, FT8, FT4, DSTAR, Fusion, DMR, Satellite, manned by 24 operators. Thank you Bob -WA3PZO, that is a lot of coordination.

As far as confirmations, 3000+ EQSL's and over 600 cards were received. These have all been answered.

All of this activity has increased our EQSL award count. This year we added:

eGrid - FT8 (431) eNAamerica - FT8 (11) ePFX300 - mixed (1126), FT8 (529) eSAamerica - mixed (10) eWAC - 17M (6), 20M (6), 40M (6), WARC (6) eWAS - FT8 (50), 40M (50), WARC (50)

HARC is looking at ways to participate in this special celebration. The 13 Colonies Special Event fits within this celebration. WM3PEN has promoted the City's history via unique qsl cards each year. With over 10,300 contacts this year (over 75% unique callsigns) in all 50 states, 78 countries on 6 continents we have a unique opportunity to promote the city. The Pennsylvania station, K2M, had an additional 20,000+ contacts. The entire 13 Colonies event had over 252,000 contacts. Besides the original 13 Colonies we shared the event with Great Britain and France.

From the Philadelphia250 website: At its heart, the story of the Declaration of Independence is about a group of ordinary people who achieved extraordinary things. It's the classic underdog victory story of insurmountable odds. Our founding fathers took on the world's greatest empire, demanded respect, envisioned a new reality, and pledged their lives to make it so. And they won. That same revolutionary spirit can be a guide for us today and as we make our way to 2026. Starting soon, PHILADELPHIA250 will engage with people all across the city and help turn ideas into creative expressions and future programming for 2026. The Declaration of Independence will be our guidepost and our inspiration. Our network of partners will help us make it so.

From the America250pa website:

The Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial (America250PA) was established by the legislature and Governor in 2018 to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate the commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States, Pennsylvania's integral role in that event, and the impact of its people on the nation's past, present, and future.

America250PA hopes to engage all citizens of the Commonwealth, from all 67 counties, bring the Commonwealth's history into the conversation so Pennsylvanians can better understand the origins and multiple perspectives of issues facing our Commonwealth & nation today, use history to encourage and inspire future leaders, celebrate the contributions of Pennsylvanians to our Commonwealth's history but also to our Nation's history, leave a lasting impact on the next generation and to spark an interest in which will ignite the drive for them to appreciate all the triumphs, trials and contributed to tribulations to which the Commonwealth for which they are now writing their own history.

From the America250 website:

America250 is a multiyear effort to commemorate the semiquincentennial, or 250th anniversary, of the United States. The purpose of the U.S. Semiquincentennial Commission, created by Congress, and the corresponding America250 Foundation is to catalyze a more perfect union by designing and leading the most comprehensive and inclusive celebration in our country's history.

America250 represents a coalition of public and private partners all working to create initiatives and programs that honor our first 250 years and inspire Americans to imagine our next 250. The commemoration period began in 2020, culminates on July 4, 2026, and officially concludes in 2027.

As we think the 13 Colonies event can play a unique role in promoting not only Philadelphia but America 250. An email has been sent to Ken, KU2US, the 13 Colonies event coordinator for his opinion.
